



Favorite ride: Take the main dirt road up to the corral. Look for the singletrack up to the granite couch on the top of the knoll--a nice overlook and a good place to eat a snack. From the corral take the jeep trail down (to start) then look for the cable trail on your left. At Dead Calf Crossing (an open area) look for a trail climbing to your left to take you to the Bear Junction Trail (old roadcut). Turn right at Bear Junction and look for the Creek Trail on your right after the next creek crossing. Then it's downhill all the way. Stay awake for the chutes & ladders at the bottom.

Variation: From the corral continue up the Case Mountain road and climb about 800 ft to the powder shack---no building anymore, just a small concrete foundation. Great view here. You can see Cinnamon Gap, Shepherd Saddle (other side of the main fork of the Kaweah), and some of the high country. Then it's down to Bear Junction and so forth.

If you still feel like riding, climb back to the Screen Door and take the singletrack down.
